

For the Love of Animals a partnership in action

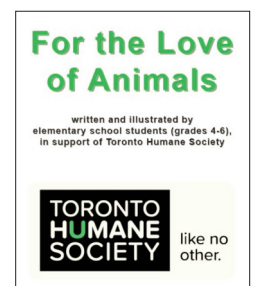
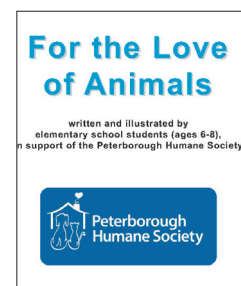
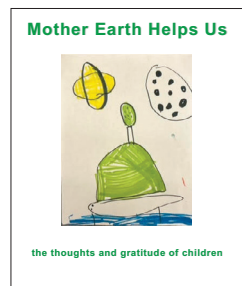
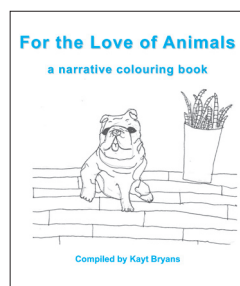
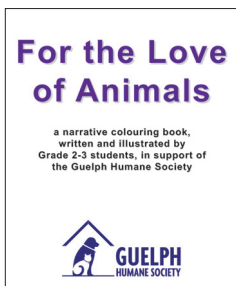
This project partners elementary school-aged children with a local humane society or animal shelter. The students write a short (300 words approx) story about their pet or other animal, and also provide a line drawing to accompany their story. Books (which can also be used as colouring books) are published by Saplings, the children's book branch of One Thousand Trees, and sold to raise funds and awareness for the local HS/shelter.

Complimentary copies are provided to each participating student, the supervising teacher, and the school library, and copies are made available for sale on Amazon.

A presentation by Malcolm Bernstein (founder of the Benjamin Project) and Lisa Browning (Publisher at One Thousand Trees) can be arranged either in person or virtually, to coincide with the presentation of the books.

To date, five books have been published as part of this project:

- *For the Love of Animals (Guelph edition)*, in support of the Guelph Humane Society
- *For the Love of Animals (Georgian Bay edition)*, in support of charities and organizations that support animal welfare
- *Mother Earth Helps Us (Tyendinaga)*, in support of the Ontario SPCA Lennox & Addington Animal Centre
- *For the Love of Animals (Peterborough edition)*, in support of the Peterborough Humane Society
- *For the Love of Animals (Toronto edition)*, in support of Toronto Humane Society
